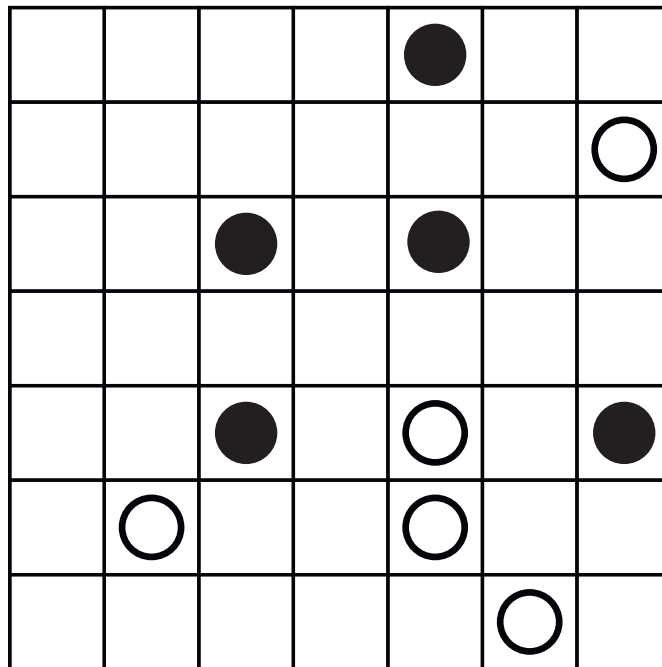


MASYU

Connect adjacent cells with vertical or horizontal lines passing through the centre of cells, so that a single loop is formed with no crossings, branches or shared cells. The loop must pass through all cells containing black or white circles. When passing through a white circle, the line must go straight through the cell, then immediately make a right-angled turn in at least one of the directly adjacent cells it passes through. When passing through a black circle, the line must make a right-angled turn in that cell, but must run straight through the directly adjacent cells on either side that it passes through.



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
